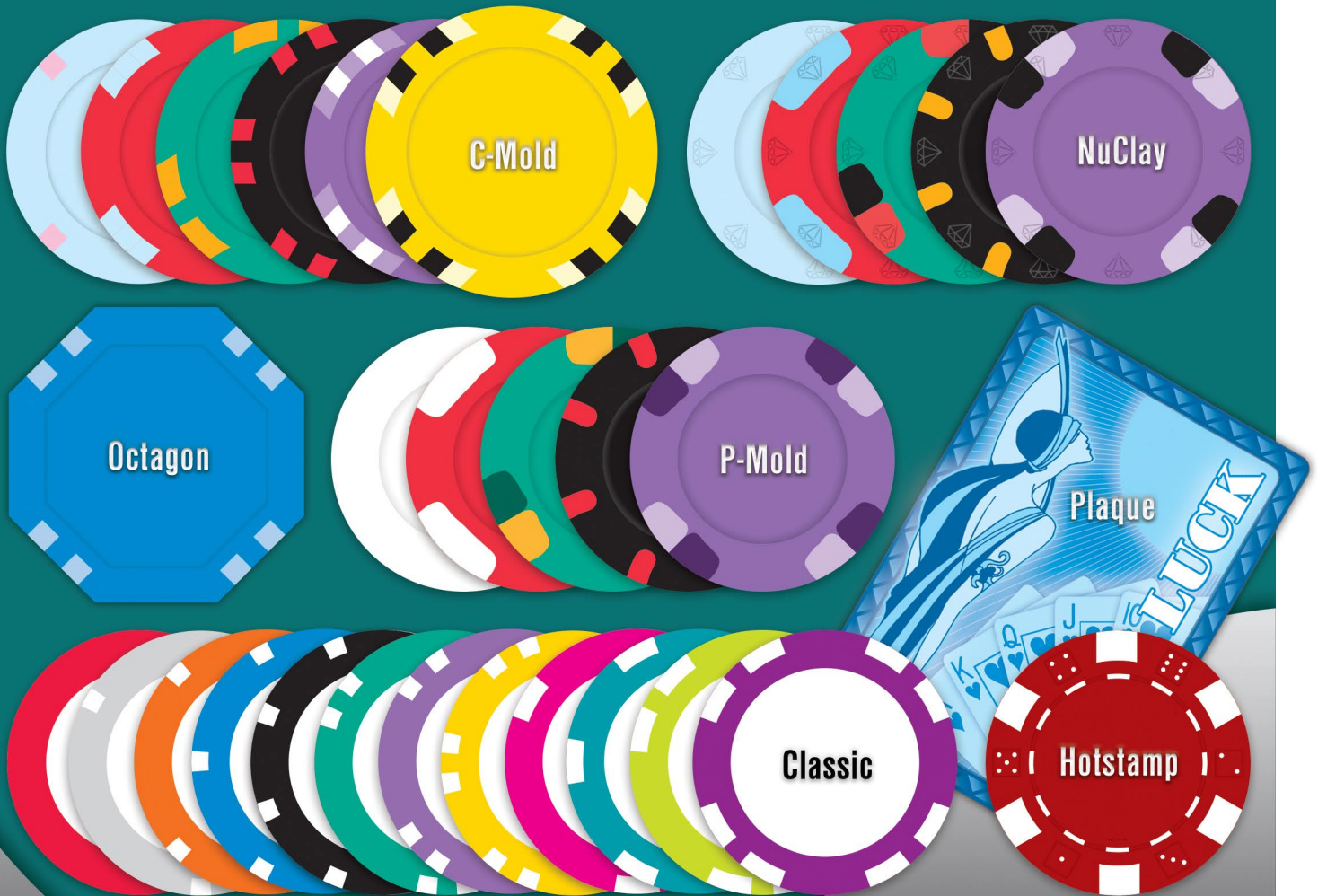

## FILE FORMATS

Artwork Submitted	Application	Format	Resolution
Designs/Artwork Files:	Adobe Illustrator	.ai / .eps	Vector
Placed/linked Files:	Adobe Photoshop	.eps / .psd / .tif	Raster (300dpi)

- If you are submitting a photograph for us to use in your design, it should have a resolution of 300dpi or better.
- If you are submitting a logo for us to use in your design, it should be a vector file (preferably Adobe Illustrator). If your logo file is not in vector format, please make sure its resolution is 300dpi or better.
- When submitting Photoshop files, please include the layered version when possible.

### CHIP EDGES (*Edge Printing*)

It is possible to add type to the edge of your chips (casino name, denominations, etc...) If you would like to have edge printing on your chips, please specify what text you'd like to add and we'll apply it to your edges. Please note that space is limited. For clarity and legibility we use a 6 point Arial Regular font for our edge printing.

### OTHER FILE FORMATS

We will do our best to work with the files you submit regardless of the format or the application that created them, but in general, the files and formats listed above will yield the best and most predictable results. When all else fails, most applications offer the option to save your file as a PDF. Select this option, send us the file and we will contact you if we encounter any problems.

### SUBMITTING FILES TO US

Most files can be submitted to us via email (artwork@securechips.com) following the file format guidelines above. If your files need to be sent to us on disk, please burn/copy them to a standard CD or DVD. The standard software settings for most CD/DVD writers/burners will create a data disk that is readable by our computers. We can also accept hardcopies, photographs, etc. via mail which we can input by scanner and then used in your artwork.

### FONTS

Please be sure to convert all your fonts to outlines/curves before submitting your files.

## GENERAL PRACTICES/TIPS

### VECTOR vs RASTER

In general, it is best to use a vector design application (Adobe Illustrator) to create your chip artwork or submit logos. This will produce the best results especially in areas that contain high levels of detail. Raster images (photographs) are best used for including a photograph of a person, building, landmark, etc. in your design. In general, raster images do not fair as well as vector images when producing type, thin lines and more complex artwork/designs.

### COLORS

All submitted files should be in CMYK mode. Files submitted in RGB mode or containing RGB elements will be converted to the CMYK mode. This conversion can, and usually does, change the appearance of the artwork.

### TYPE

Chip artwork is almost always confined to a very small area - usually a circular area somewhere between 27.5mm and 43mm in diameter. Due to these small sizes, we generally suggest a minimum font size of approximately 6 points and also suggest (especially at these smaller font sizes) using fonts that are easier to read.

### PROOFING

Please, thoroughly proof your artwork before you send it to us *and* after we send you a proof for review.

### ADDING UV SECURITY

UV markings must be placed over an area of the chip/plaque that is 100% white. Please leave enough white space in your designs to accommodate the UV markings that will appear on your final product.
